
## NZ AFG BOARD NEVSLETTER FEB Creating Enthusiasm for Service! 2025


## CONFERENCE 2025 IS GO!

We are especially grateful to the willing and enthusiastic members who saw our S>O>S, responded to the request for help, stepped up with open minds and hearts to be our new Conference


Committee. Thanks to their efforts the 2025 Conference is off the ground. Woo hoo! They have committed to service continuity and succession planning, nurturing new members into roles with
